SRLAAW and Library Legislative Day

On February 11-12, I attended SRLAAW and Library Legislative Day in Madison. A major topic of discussion at the SRLAAW meeting was the new LSTA grant category: Collaborative Projects to Increase Capacity for Technology Tools and Resources. This grant opportunity requires intersystem collaboration and has an unusually short window for project completion. OWLS and NFLS have committed our LSTA allocations and additional OWLSnet funds to a statewide back-up project. A committee of system technology staff from around the state proposed the project, and SCLS will be the fiscal agent.

Snow prevented many people from attending Library Legislative Day this year, but I was pleased to see OWLS Trustee Bobbie Buchholtz and OWLS member Director Elizabeth Timmins at the capitol. I met with staff of Senator Roger Roth and Representative Amanda Stuck.
